

Information Bulletin for Parents/Guardians

As a follow up to the Information Bulletin of January 21, 2022 to parents and guardians, we want to provide an update on the availability of rapid antigen test (RAT) kits.

We have provided each elementary student participating in in-person learning with two Rapid Antigen Tests for home use. All secondary students will be provided no later than February 7, 2022, a test kit for home use to be used if they are symptomatic.

We have now received an additional supply of rapid antigen tests that will be provided to those students who have used their initial distribution of test kits and are returning from an unplanned absence. These tests are being delivered to school this week and will be available to students on February 7, 2022.

Individuals who receive a positive test result **should not** participate in antigen testing for 30 days from their COVID-19 infection. After this period, symptomatic individuals can resume rapid antigen testing.

These replacement test kits will be made available at the office of your school.
